MINUTES OF JUNE 11, 2008

The minutes of the June 11, 2008 City Council meeting were discussed and approved. Motion made by Miller, seconded by Danford. Motion carried.

Balance Sheet and P&L – The Treasurer presented the balance sheet and the P&L for the Council’s review of the upcoming budget. There was a lengthy discussion on the P&L, how the format of the reports should be presented and what information the Council needed to make well informed decisions. The Clerk took note of the changes that the Council wanted to make.

Budget Workshop – The Clerk and the Treasurer presented the first draft of the budget. The Council questioned the format of the budget and what the line items meant. The Treasurer stated that the reports were generated from Quick Books and that they were self-explanatory.

Signing of Road Maintenance MOU with Post Falls Highway District – Councilmember Danford suggested that we postpone this discussion for a future meeting.

Discussion of Sign Violations and Amending the Code – The Code Administrator reminded the Council that this was a continued discussion from the June 11, 2008 meeting and that she requested direction from the Council on the current sign violations. Councilmember Danford questioned the ability to amend the Development Code. Additional discussions centered on the signs that were needed in the City, such as street signs. She was instructed to enforce the regulations, however develop language that would allow for community signage.

Janitor and Cleaning the Building – There was a discussion regarding the quality of the janitorial work.
